Matthew 26 And at verse 36 Then Jesus went with them To a place called Gethsemane And he said to his disciples Sit here while I go over there And pray And taking with him Peter and the two sons Of Zebedee He began to be sorrowful And troubled Then he said to them My soul is very sorrowful Even to death Remain here And watch with me We're going to ask And God willing Answer from God's word Two questions tonight Who is this Jesus Of Nazareth That we see And we meet Going through The gates Of the garden Of Gethsemane Who is he?

The second question We're going to ask is Why is this Jesus Sorrowful And troubled? Who is this Jesus That we meet In Gethsemane?

Paul tells us In Colossians chapter 1 That he is the image Of the invisible God He also tells us In that letter In him The whole fullness Of deity Dwells bodily This is the word Of God Become flesh This is the one Who filled And continued To control The whole universe While he was still In the womb Of his mother This is the one Who had no earthly father But was conceived By the Holy Spirit Of God This is the one Who was with his father From all eternity This is the one Who appeared To the patriarchs In the Old Testament

[30:17] As an angel This is the one Who was in the fiery furnace With Shadrach Meshach And Abednego And what did they say?

He looks as though He were a son Of the gods This is the one Who is described In the book of Daniel As the ancient Of days This is the one Of the which The prophets Would say For to us A child is born Mighty God Prince Of peace This is the one Of which the prophet Would say This is Emmanuel This is God With us This is Jesus Of Nazareth This is the Jesus We meet The Lord And Saviour Our Lord And Saviour This is the Jesus We meet In Gethsemane This is the

God Man This is the one Who never ceased To be God For one Moment This is the one Who could read The minds And the hearts Of those Around him Yet this is the one Who could still Be amazed At the faith Of a Roman Centurion It's interesting Isn't it?

This is the one Who could walk On water And feed Five thousand With five loaves And two fish Yet He would say To the woman Of Samaria What did he say?

I thirst I thirst This is the one Who forecasted Future events Telling the disciples To collect A donkey And there it was In the very spot Where he said It would be As he headed To Jerusalem To the cross And yet he confesses He does not know The date of his return How so?

This is Jesus Of Nazareth And it's because Of this glorious Jesus of Nazareth That we are here Tonight This is the one Of which we confess In our tradition He is perfect In Godhood And he is also Perfect In manhood He is truly God And truly man He is two natures The incarnate Christ He is one Glorious person With God's nature And for our sake A human nature So let's pause For a few moments As we Take all that in Let's back up here

A wee bit And think about You know The Lord Jesus Confessing He did not know The date of his return He's going to return Yes we know He confesses He doesn't know Because In order for Jesus To save He had to become Like us In order for Jesus To save He had to Touch Hebrews 2 You know That verse 17 Says this He had to be made Like his brothers In every respect There was one difference There wasn't there He was without sin We have been Ruined By Sin For we do not Have a high priest Hebrews tells us

That is Jesus We do not have A high priest Who is unable To sympathize With our weakness And we are weak Aren't we But we have one Who in every respect Has been tempted As we are Yet he was Without sin Yet he can Sympathize with you And he can Sympathize with me Peter would say He is Christ He is a lamb Without spot Or blemish He is Perfect John would say Luke The lamb Of God Who takes away The sin Of the world And Paul And Paul Would throw His arms Up in the air As he is Writing his letter To Timothy And he would say Great indeed Great indeed We confess This The mystery Of godliness

> Said Hundreds Of years Before Prior To Christ Coming In the Flesh And Entering Into This World Isaiah 53 3 You Know The Words Well He Was Despised And Rejected He Was A Man Of Sorrows Acquainted With Grief And We See The Grief Here As He Contemplates Going To The Cross Of Calvary To Save A Sinful People You Know We Worship A Saviour Who Experienced Grief And Sorrow Like No Other This Is The One Who Earlier Upon Entering Into Jerusalem He Wept Over It He Cried Over It Just Like Jeremiah Centuries Before Weeping

And Pleading And Finding Nothing But Hardness Of Heart And Unbelief You See Jesus Would Weep Over The Impending Destruction Of Jerusalem Who Is This Jesus This Is The Jesus Who Wept Over The Death Of His Friend Lazarus Do You Remember Go Go to John 11 And You See The Death Of Lazarus The Text Says He Was Deeply Moved He Was Indignant In His Spirit And He Was Greatly Troubled John 11 33 And It's Not So Much Yes He Was Sad The Lord Jesus And He Was Grieving At The Death Of His Friend Lazarus But There Was More To It Than That There Was More To It Than That Why Was He So Moved

So That We Would Not Be Left On Our Own Because When We Put Our Faith And Our Trust In This Jesus We Meet In Gethsemane We Do Not Live The Christian Life On Our Own We Live As We Hared Yesterday Before The Face Of God In The Presence Of God Lord Jesus Christ Has Promised To Be To Be With His People Even Until The World Jesus Did Not Have That Luxury In Gethsemane By He Headed To The Cross This Is Not A Phantom Of A Man This Is The God Man The Sportless Lamb Of God Who Came To Take Away The Sin Of The World This Is The One Mediator Between God And Man The Man Christ Jesus

Worship And That We're Called To Do To Learn More About The One Who Loved Us And Gave Himself For Us To Learn About Him Benjamin Warfield Says This About The Emotional Life Of Jesus It Cannot Be Supposed That Jesus Prosecuted His Work On Earth He Says In A State Of Mental Depression No He Says He Came Into The World On A Mission Of Ministering Good News And Mercy For The Lost Giving His Life As A Ransom For Many Warfield Says And Warfield Also Says This And This Is Interesting And I'm Glad He Said It This Joy Underlay All His Suffering Even In Amongst All His Suffering It Was A Joy Underneath It All A Joy And A Love For His People A Joy That He Was Going To Save A People

For Himself Warfield And I Carry On If Our Lord Was The Man Of Sorrows He Says He Was More Profoundly Still The Man Of Joy The Man Of Joy Do You Have Joy In Your Heart Here This Evening Of Jesus Do You Have A Love In Your Heart This Evening For Jesus Are You Seeing And Learning Something Over Here About Jesus This Is The Jesus We Meet In Get Salmon But Yet The Prospect Of His Suffering Was A Perpetual Get Salmon He Must Bow His Head Beneath This Straw And He Would Do It For You And He Would Do It For Me And

I'm Going To Quote Warfield Again And I Want You To Listen Carefully To What He Says In The Presence Of This Mental Anguish The Physical Torture Of The Crucifixion They Retire Into The Background And We May Well Believe That Our Lord Though He Died On The Cross Yet Died Not Off The Cross But As We Commonly Say He Died Of A Broken Heart That Is To Say The Strain Of His Mental Sufferings All For The Joy That Was Set Before Him And Now Where Is The Lord Jesus He Is Seated At The Right Hand Of God And Giving All The Benefits Of The Gospel To Us Even Here This Evening He Died Because Of The Sin Of All Of God's People In Every Place And In Every Era Of This World's

History Because On His Shoulders Was Charged Your Sin And My Sin Paul Tells The Corinthians You Were Bought With A Price Have You Seen Something Of The Price Here In Get Seminy What A Price The Price Is The Blood Of The Son Of God You Were Bought With That Price What a Saviour In Worship What a Saviour Here He Is All Alone And We Are The Price Of God And We Have Each Other And We Live The Christian Lives Together And Jesus Did It For Us All Long

And When We Read This Text And We Meditate And Think Upon It And We Look At Our Own Sinful Hearts Do We Not Say Lord I Wish I Loved You More Lord I Wish I Was More Committed To You After All You Have Done For Me One Of My Favourite Texts In The Holy Scripture From The Apostle Paul In Second Timothy Chapter Two And Verse Thirteen It Says If We Are Faithless Which We Are So Often If We Are Faithless He Remains Faithful To Us Faithful To

Us Christ Has Purchased Our Salvation Through Great Suffering Do Do you Believe In Jesus Here This Even Have You Made Your Peace With Jesus Because Because In The Preaching Of The Gospel The Lord Jesus Comes To You This Night And He Comes With You Clothed In The Gospel And He Comes In Love And He Calls You To Put Your Trust And To Put Your Faith In Him We Are We Are We Have No Hope Out With Jesus
